# Baylands Recovery Project

## *at the Former Peninsula Sportsmen's Club*

San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) will resume Phase I clean up and restoration of its water supply right-of-way near the Dumbarton Bridge in Menlo Park adjoining East Palo Alto.

From January to March 2004, the contractor will excavate, treat and off-haul contaminated soils in the Seasonal Pond Area and in the Clay Pigeon Debris Area, formerly the firing range of the sportsmen's club. Contractor's work hours will be Monday through Friday 7:00AM to 5:00 PM with truck transporting hours from 8:00AM to 3:00 PM.



The contractor will treat and off-haul the material to a designated disposal facility. Stringent health and safety measures, procedures, and environmental monitoring will be strictly enforced at the site. The entire work area will be secured with fencing along with 24-hour security.

# Proyecto de Recuperación de Baylands

## *En el antiguo Peninsula Sportsmen's Club*

La Comisión de Servicios Públicos de San Francisco (San Francisco Public Utilities Commission) (SFPUC) continuará la primera fase de limpieza y reanudación del derecho de vía de la red de agua cerca del Puente Dumbarton (Dumbarton Bridge) en Menlo Park junto a East Palo Alto.

De enero a marzo del 2004, el contratista excavará, tratará y retirará los sedimentos contaminados del área de Seasonal Pond, y en la zona de Clay Pigeon Debris (área de desperdicios de tiro al disco), donde antes operaba el campo de tiro del Sportsmen's Club. El horario del contratista será de lunes a viernes de las 7:00AM a las 5:00 PM con tráfico de camiones de las 8:00AM a las 3:00 PM.



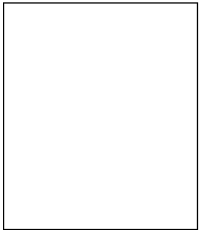
El contratista tratará y retirará el material hacia un depósito de desechos. Se aplicarán medidas y procedimientos estrictos de salud pública, seguridad y monitoreo ambiental en dicha área. Toda la zona de operación estará cercada y vigilada las 24 horas del día.
