

## PUBLIC ACCESS & RECREATION

The overarching goal of the Long-Term Restoration Plan is the restoration and enhancement of wetlands in the South San Francisco Bay while providing for flood management and *wildlife-oriented public access and recreation*.

**Objective 3. Provide public access and recreational opportunities compatible with wildlife and habitat goals. (Stakeholder Forum 2/18/04)**

Enhance opportunity for visual experience.	Number of viewing areas/viewpoints/ scenic overlooks
