
DIRECTIONS

MOFFETT PUBLIC AFFAIRS BUILDING - EAGLE ROOM NASA AMES RESEARCH CENTER, MOFFETT FIELD, MOUNTAIN VIEW

From San Jose

- Take Highway 101 North
- Drive approximately 9 miles (from San Jose Airport)
- Exit on Moffett Field (second Moffett Field exit, not "Southgate" Ellis Street); Turn right (east).
- Stay in right lane and turn right just before security gate.
- At the stop sign, there will be a large white "tent" building—the

Ames Exploration Center. Turn right and circle behind the Center to the parking area.



Walk around to the front of the Center and cross the street to the Gift Shop/Public Affairs Building. Enter in the right side at the Public Affairs Entrance.

San

From San Francisco

- Take Highway 101 South
- Drive approximately 30 miles (from San Francisco Airport)
- Exit on Moffett Field (not Moffett Boulevard) go under bridge and then over the freeway
- Stay in right lane and turn right just before security gate.
- At the stop sign, there will be a large white "tent" building—the Ames Exploration Center. Turn right and circle behind the Center to the parking area.
- Walk around to the front of the Center and cross the street to the Gift Shop/Public Affairs Building. Enter in the right side at the Public Affairs Entrance.

From East Bay

- Take Highway 880 to the Dumbarton Bridge; Cross the bridge
- Follow signs to CA-114, which connects to Highway 101 South
- Take Highway 101 South until and exit on Moffett Field (not Moffett Boulevard) go under bridge and then over the freeway
- Stay in right lane and turn right just before security gate.
- At the stop sign, there will be a large white "tent" building—the Ames Exploration Center. Turn right and circle behind the Center to the parking area.
- Walk around to the front of the Center and cross the street to the Gift Shop/Public Affairs Building. Enter in the right side at the Public Affairs Entrance.
