## Driving:

From Highway 84 (at the east end of the Dumbarton Bridge), exit at Thornton Avenue. Travel south on Thornton Avenue for o.8 miles to the Refuge entrance on the right. Turn right into the Refuge and turn left at the stop sign into the second parking lot. The auditorium is located at the top of hill in the Refuge Administrative Headquarters building.
