**Subject: Extension of the Comment Period for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR) for the South Bay Salt Pond Restoration Project, Phase 2**

**Date: September 21, 2015**

The California State Coastal Conservancy, Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), Lead Agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) have prepared a joint Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR) for Phase 2 of the South Bay Salt Pond Restoration Project. We need to know the views of the public and agencies regarding the scope and content of the environmental information included in that EIS/EIR. For agencies, these comments should be limited to the environmental information that is germane to your agency's statutory responsibilities in connection with the proposed project, including your use when considering a permit or other approval for the project.

**This notice is to inform you that the California Coastal Conservancy and the USFWS will extend the comment period until October 30, 2015.**
