You are invited to the annual meeting of the South Bay Salt Pond Restoration Project Stakeholder Forum, to be held on Thursday, October 20, 2011, from 1-4 p.m. at the offices of the Alameda County Flood Control District, Rooms 230 A/B/C, 951 Turner Court, Hayward, CA.

The focus of this annual meeting will be on the tremendous progress made by the Project in the past year expanding tidal habitat restoration and developing detailed designs for flood management in the far South Bay.
